

The Scout and Guide Movement

Scouting and Guiding is a Non-Religious, Non-Political, Non-Sectarian, secular and uniformed youth movement.

The four pillars of Scouting / Guiding namely

- 1. Character & intelligence
- 2. Handicraft & Skill
- 3. Health & Hygiene
- 4. Service.

First Scout Camp and Foundation of Scouting Movement

Birth of the Movement

The Founder of our Movement, Robert Stephenson Smyth Baden Powell, was born in London, England on 22nd February, 1857. As a Captain of the Royal British Army, he was assigned the task of fighting the tribal's in the jungles of South Africa in 1887. To assess the movements of the opponents in the jungles, he had recruited local boys in the age groups of 14-25 to scout around and gather information about enemy movements as well as pass on messages to his own groups of soldiers.

After Baden Powell returned to England from this' African assignment, his experience conceptualized into the "Boy Scout" movement in the year 1907. He thought if illiterate boys could work and move fast in gathering information and delivering messages during war times, why not train them to be better citizens and useful human beings of society in peacetimes

Purpose of the Movement:

The purpose of the Movement is to contribute to, the development of young people in achieving their full physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual potentials as individuals, as responsible citizens and as members of the local, national and international communities.

SCOUTING IN WORLD

The Boy Scout Movement had a simple start in the year 1907 when a Major General of Army Lord Baden Powell conducted an experimental camp in Brown sea Island in England, with 20 boys. The successful conduct of the camp and publication of the Book "Scouting for Boys" in a fortnightly marked the start of the Boy Scout Movement. In the year 1910, Crystal Palace Rally was held where Girls wearing the Boy Scout uniform appeared and wanted to join the Scout Movement. Lord Baden Powell decided to start a movement for Girls with the help of his sister Agnes Baden Powell.


SCOUTING IN INDIA

Scouting started in India in the year 1909, when Captain T.H.Baker established the first Scout Troop at the Bishop Cotton Boys' School in Bangalore and got it registered with Imperial Headquarters, London. Subsequently, Scout Troops were formed in Kirkee, Pune, Shimla, Madras, Jabalpur, Lonavla (Mumbai) and

registered with the Imperial Headquarters during 1910 and 1911. These units were open to European and Anglo Indian Children only. The first Guide Company in India was started in Jabalpur, Central India in 1911. As the Scout Movement was not initially open to the Indian boys, Nationalist leaders of India decided to offer Scouting activities to Indian Boys and Seva Samithi Scout Association was formed with Headquarters in Allahabad by Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, Pandit H N Kunzru and Pandit Sriram Bajpai.Dr.Annie Besant with the help of Shri G.S.Arundale started a separate Scout Association for Indian Boys in Madras. Efforts were made for unification of different scout groups existing in India during the visit of Lord Baden Powell to India in 1921 and 1937 but failed. Major reason for the failure in unification was the promise clause which included the word "Duty to King". Our Patriotic sentiments of our Nationalist leaders did not approve the allegiance to the British Empire and instead it was insisted that allegiance loyalty to the Country should be part of the Scout Promise.

SCOUTING GUIDING IN INDEPENDENT INDIA

After the independence of our country efforts were made for unification of the Scout and Guide Associations functioning in India. incessant efforts were made by our National leaders like Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, First Prime Minister of India Mr.Maulana Abdul Kalam Azad, the First Education Minister of India, Shri Mangal Das Pakwasa, Governor of Central Province, and Scout Leaders Pandit H N Kunzru, Pandit Sri Ram Bajpai, Justice Vivian Bose and others for the merger of the Scout /Guide Associations. Dr.TaraChand, Education Secretary, Government of India made a significant contribution in finalizing the merger deed. The Final merger took place on 7th November 1950 and the Unified Organization came into existence under the Name "The Bharat Scouts and Guides" The Girl Guides Association formally joined the Bharat Scouts and Guides a later on 15th August 1951.



CONSTITUTION AND HEADQUARTERS

The Bharat Scouts and Guides is a Registered Society under Societies Registrations Act. It is totally voluntary, non-political and secular Organization the National Headquarters of the Bharat Scouts and Guides functioned from Regal Building, Connaught Place, New Delhi, till 1963. Thereafter, it shifted to its own building and is Functioning from Lakshmi Mazumdar Bhawan , Mahatma Gandhi Marg, Indra Prasth Estate, New Delhi. The National Headquarters building was inaugurated in the year 1963 by the then Vice President of India Dr.Zakir Hussain.

Mission

"The Mission of Scouting is to contribute to the education of young people, through a value system based on the Scout Promise and Law, to help build a better world where people are self-fulfilled as individuals and play a constructive role in society."

Aims, Objectives, Methods & Fundamentals

Scouting/Guiding is an organization designed for youth and every youth should claim an equal right to it. The values and ideas it aims to instill in youth are the need of the hour. These values are rightfully relevant in helping youth in achieving their full potential. It helps youth develop necessary skills such as academic skills, ethics, leadership skills, self-confidence and citizenship skills that is used in their life further. Being a part of worldwide community, it becomes imperative for us to work for the betterment of the society and that begins by working on ourselves and then making valuable contribution in our society.

Our aim is to train the youth for good citizenship. Active citizenship is natural to all, but we want to eradicate it. In the place of "Self" we substitute "the ambition to be of service to fellowmen". We want them to become actively loyal to the community. While training for good citizenship is our ultimate aim but our immediate aim, however is character formation, building of sound health-habits, training in handicrafts and useful skills, and cultivation of proper spirit of service. Through these we want to build in our youth a proper sense of service.

- I. Character We teach character through patrol system, Scout & Guide Law, Scout & Guide lore, woodcraft, and responsibility of a patrol leader, team games, and there resourcefulness involved in camp work. Character training includes the realization of God, the Creator through His work, appreciating beauty of Nature via inculcating love and care of plants and animals..
- II. **Health And Strength** —We secure health and strength through games, regularity in exercises, yoga and through knowledge of personal hygiene and diet.
- m. Handicraft and Skill—These are achieved occasionally through indoor activities, but more especially through pioneering, bridge-building, camp expeditions, and self-expression through arts all of which together make us efficient workers.
- w. Service to Others —The spirit of service is developed by practicing religion, "Good turns", i.e., making quite small actions, with community service, accidents and lifesaving.

The Scout and Guide Movement has its foundation on certain fundamental principles as follows:

- 1. Belief in God,
- 2. Practice of the Scout Law and Promise,
- 3. Use of outdoor activities,
- 4. Voluntary membership,
- 5. Patrol Method of Patrol System,
- 6. Loyalty to country,
- 7. Faith in world friendship,
- 8. Independent of political influence,
- 9. Learning by doing,
- 10. Service to others and
- 11. Faith in Indian culture.

Faith in God and belief in His goodness is important. There is no place in the movement for those who do not believe in God. Duty to God is one of the duties that a scout or guide has to bear in mind. They have to be taught that God is kind to everyone and has abundant love for all..

Outdoor life and all activities in the open are the working principle followed in the Movement. We believe in doing all our work outdoors. Only rarely we do our work indoors, and then we do only so for the reason that the weather is inclement.

Boys and girls join Scouting and guiding voluntarily. They join out of their free will. They do not do so out of compulsion or under inducement.
















